## LETTING CONDITIONS FOR LICENSED BAR

1. It is the responsibility of the Hirer who wishes to provide alcoholic drinks at a function to obtain the relevant licence.
2. The permanent bar in the Small Hall shall be used and the Hirer is responsible for leaving the premises in a clean and tidy condition.
3. No other bar may be set up or other bar fittings or furniture used.
4. A deposit of £50 shall be paid when making the booking for the bar, refundable in whole or part against damage and dependent upon the conditions of the bar premises at the end of the let.
5. The bar will close at least 30 minutes before the end of the function. However, should the time for closing as shown on the Occasional Licence be earlier then the conditions of the licence will take precedence.
6. The Hirer will make a copy of the Occasional Licence available to the Booking Secretary at least one week before the function.
7. The name of the Licensee (Public House etc) is to be submitted along with the booking application. A village Public House is preferred if possible.
8. A copy of the licence is to be exhibited on the bar during the whole period the bar is open.
9. The Committee reserves the right to refuse permission for a bar without giving a reason.
